## **European projects of PostEurop, the European organisation of postal operators**

**PostEurop has taken initiatives in cooperation with the European Commission.**



### **1) A project within the framework of the European Social Dialogue Committee: 'Trend research for the postal sector in 2030'**

PostEurop's 'Corporate Social Responsibility Activities Circle' submitted in June 2017 a new project to the European Commission DG Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion.

With this project, the social partners of the European Social Dialogue Committee of the Postal Sector want to find out what the future looks like, from now to 2030, from a social perspective in the postal sector.

The aim of the project is to do research on the social impacts of upcoming evolutions, in particular as regards social, economic and environmental issues as well as the digitalisation of society, and assess what the impact of those evolutions will be on work organisation in the postal sector.

The project has been approved.

### **2) SAFEPOST II**

PostEurop has already organised a SAFEPOST project from 2012 to 2016, with funding from the DG Enterprise and Industry. The aim of the project is to identify security gaps in the postal supply chain, at national level and across European countries, and establish a common approach of European postal operators to those challenges.

Considering the success of the project, PostEurop wants to continue the initiative and is preparing SAFEPOST II. With this aim, the Safepost Working Group met on 29 November 2017 at PostEurop's headquarters in Brussels.
