## Publication of three new opinions on 9 February 2018

The Expert Panel on Effective ways of Investing in Health is an interdisciplinary and independent group, established by the European Commission, providing advice in the form of opinions in response to questions submitted by the Commission.

The Panel aims to analyse evidence that could support the EU countries in delivering high quality care and making their health systems more effective, accessible and resilient. In addition, the opinions it produces are intended to generate debate and provoke thinking amongst stakeholders, national authorities and other relevant bodies.
