Trade union education day – new member organisation from Albania

Tirana (Albania), 05.11.2018

On 05.11.2018, a meeting took place in the building of the “Union of Independent Trade Unions of Albania” (BSPSH), more in particular with the sector of public services of that trade union.

The trade union became member of Eurofedop during the meeting of the Executive Committee in Bucharest on 21.09.2018.



Arjola Alika, legal expert and moreover president of the Trade Union of Public Administration, chaired the meeting and ensured the translation EN/ALB together with a colleague.

Delegates from local administrations, ministries, culture, public service agencies, justice, tourism and health services attended the meeting.

A presentation of the Eurofedop organisation was held, with detailed information about the sectors, mission, services and activities. So far, Eurofedop’s sectoral activities have only been known by some of the Albanian colleagues in the field of health services.

Dr. Dritan Korumi, who has already used the opportunity to take part in Eurofedop sessions, is continuously striving to build a network of health care workers in Albania.



Low pay, poor working conditions, the brain drain, are problems which the sector of health services but also other sectors of the public service are trying to cope with. When not all of the money meant for the sectors does not reach those sectors, is not an exception in Albania.

Agreements were made to plan further steps of integration of the trade union in Eurofedop's working programme.

They will be present at the meeting with Commissioner Hahn in Vienna and use the occasion to express their point of view on the enlargement from the side of this trade union of Albania.
