***Yesterday, 5th November 2020,
the representatives of Federația „Solidaritatea Sanitară” din România
protested in front of the Government***

The representatives of Federația „Solidaritatea Sanitară” din România protested yesterday, 05.XI.2020, starting with 14:00, in front of the Government (Victoriei Square).

The protest, called the Rally for Decent Working Conditions, was dedicated to defending the rights of healthcare workers to decent working conditions and to recognizing their merits, as presented in the Health Workers' Call for Decent Working Conditions.

This action was attended by the maximum number of people allowed by law, respectively 100, being the first demonstration in the street dedicated exclusively to defending the rights and interests of all workers in the public healthcare system. This was the first protest in the series of those scheduled every Thursday of the week by the "Sanitary Solidarity" Federation, until the requests are resolved.

A memorandum with the demands of Federația „Solidaritatea Sanitară” din România was submitted to the Romanian Government, together with the resumption of the request to start the dialogue in order to solve the notified problems.

The following requests are on the list of claims of Federația „Solidaritatea Sanitară” din România:

- take all necessary measures to protect the health and safety of health workers (equipment, circuits, material and human resources) as to lead to a significant reduction in the number of SARS-CoV-2 infected employees and, in particular, deaths from COVID-19 causes;*
- ensuring access to all relevant information on the impact of COVID-19 on health workers;*
- observance of the legal right to the survivor's pension for the children of colleagues who died on duty;*
- granting all salary rights provided by law, respectively:
 - an increase of up to 30%*
 - the increase to fight the epidemic;**
- granting all bonuses for maximum working conditions;*
- increase of basic salaries for all categories of workers starting with January 1, 2021 at the level of 2022;*
- the possibility to benefit from the reduction of the contribution period (retirement age) in proportion to the activity carried out above the basic norm;*
- granting the risk incentive for the entire duration of the alert for all health workers;*
- resetting the nurses in the salary scale;*
- the declaration of COVID-19 as an occupational disease for health workers;*

- negotiating the annexes to the collective labor agreement at sector level that allow to increase the quality of professional life;
- payment of the guards with the hourly tariff afferent to the basic norm;
- reporting all increases to current basic salaries.

In order to overcome the COVID-19 pandemic, Romania needs the full support of health workers. In order to successfully continue this struggle, health professionals need decent working conditions and recognition of merits, respectively the full support of the Government and society. The indifference of the government to the situation and the rights of health workers must cease, turning into due attention to the needs and expectations of these people at the forefront of the fight against COVID-19.
